Choose Cohoes for Art Scholarship Fund

In 2006 a high school teacher gave her class an assignment to write to an author, discuss the author's work and ask for advice. Kurt Vonnegut was the only author to respond. Among other things he said:

"What I had to say to you, moreover, would not take long, to wit: Practice any art, music, singing, dancing, acting, drawing, painting, sculpting, poetry, fiction, essays, reportage, no matter how well or badly, not to get money and fame, but to experience becoming, to find out what's inside you, to make your soul grow.

Seriously! I mean starting right now, do art and do it for the rest of your lives..."

The Choose Cohoes for Art Committee believes that the arts enhance the quality of life in any community where they are supported and allowed to flourish. The activities that the committee produces are part of our effort to support and allow art to flourish in Cohoes. Earlier this year we held our first "Gala" style event. At the Moon Glow Gala we established a scholarship fund with the proceeds of that event. As we go forward it is our intent to add to the fund with a portion of the proceeds of any future events. At this event, our fund raising activities include ads by sponsors in the show catalog and the silent auction.

In establishing the scholarship fund we have set the five following requirements for the recipient:

- 1. Participation in the Cohoes Artist Showcase IV to be held May 16-17, 2014.
- 2. The student must display their 5 best pieces, which will be judged by a panel from the committee.
- 3. An Artist Statement must be included in the Showcase Entry.
- 4. The student must have a letter of acceptance/commitment to an institute of higher learning in an arts focused program.
- 5. The student must be a senior registered at Cohoes High School.

Please take the time to visit the student art display. Please consider making a bid in the silent auction to help us in our efforts to promote and support art.






